

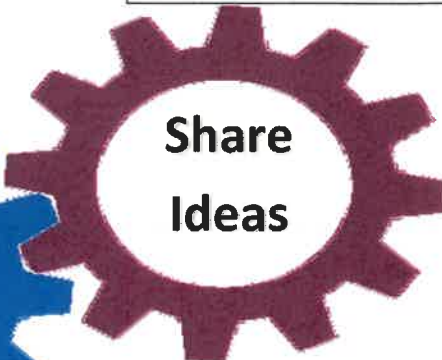

Peggy/Morgan's Classroom updates:

They are starting off the new year learning about the story The Gingerbread Man. They will be sequence of the story, counting gingerbread man and play with cinnamon scented playdough. They are introducing early science experiments by dissolving a gingerbread cookie using water, milk, and vinegar to predict which will make the cookie dissolve faster. They will be making a gingerbread man cookie that will "disappear" from the oven and with help from other staff they will go looking for him.

At the end of the month, they will be learning about snow and ice. They will make pretend snow and have an indoor snowball fight. The children will create their own snowy picture using black paper and white paint. They will be displayed for winter season.

Lynel/Cheryl's Classroom updates:

They are learning about animals in the winter and winter in general. They bring snow in when there is enough outside. They will also make some fake snow. They are making white play dough and are using it to make little snowmen. Please ask your child what it means to hibernate or what it's called to sleep all winter.

Shelby/Becky's Classroom updates:

We introduced the new Teacher Shelby. She told us about everything new in their classroom. They are getting to know each other. They are working on Social/Emotional and screening the children to see where they fall in ELS.

Becca/Lindsey's Classroom updates:

They are talking about Artic Animals. How they stay warm, and the different animals that like the now and dislike the snow. They will be doing the blubber experiment with the children.

They will also be learning about clothing (socks, hats, gloves, pants, and shirts) They will be having a fashion show in their classroom. They are asking for donations for clothes and shoes.

They will also be talking about dental care at the end of the month.

We are still working on Social/Emotions and reviewing our classroom expectations, sharing the way we feel this way and working on classroom routines.

When their child is struggling with emotions, they can use the feeling slider as a visual to help their child recognize and talk about their feelings.

For the month of January, we have started off about talking about Artic Animals. We have discussed how they start warm, and the different animals that like the snow and dislike the snow. We will be doing the blubber experiment tomorrow with the children. Then, the next two weeks we will be focusing on clothing. We will talk about how they keep us warm, the different types of clothing (socks, hats, gloves, pants, shirts) and we will be having a fashion show. If you have any clothing items or shoes you would like to donate for this activity, we would appreciate it. The last week of January we will be talking about dental care, as we have the dentist coming that week.

Social and emotional we have been reviewing our classroom expectations, talking about emotions, and sharing why we feel this way, and working on classroom routines.
