This activity is for your child to learn to recognize numbers and practice counting. Have your child cut out each heart. Then, have your child cut the middle of the heart to separate the number from the mini hearts. Ask your child to name the numbers that are on each card. Next, match up the number portion of the heart to the corresponding piece with the appropriate quantity of mini hearts. You can also ask your child to count as far as he or she can out loud.
